
\$smarty_var could be:

Foreach Loop

```
<foreach item=block from=$xoBlocks.canvas_left>

</foreach>
```

\$xoBlocks.canvas_left describes the block location

canvas_left could be replaced by

Tag / Code	Example Usage / Comment
<{xoAppUrl backend.php}>	<link rel="alternate" type="application/rss+xml" title="RSS" href="<{xoAppUrl backend.php}>" />
<{xoAppUrl xoops.css}>	<link rel="stylesheet" type="text/css" media="screen" href="<{xoAppUrl xoops.css}>" />
<{xoImgUrl style.css}>	<link rel="stylesheet" type="text/css" media="all" href="<{xoImgUrl style.css}>" />
<{\$xoops_themecss}>	<link rel="stylesheet" type="text/css" media="all" href="<{\$xoops_themecss}>" />
