To install the Node.js version 8 or superior, go to the official website at www.nodejs.org. You'll find a download link for your operative system and be given the choice to install the latest Stable version or Long Term Support (LTS) version. For our usage, it's advisable to use the LTS version but any of the two versions is acceptable.

Just download the installation package and run it. If you need a different type of operative system, click on "Downloads" on the top menu and choose the appropriate one. If you use a Linux distribution and prefer to use the package manager, there are instructions for the most common ones on the bottom of the page.
